

## 2025 Annual ISPA Report

---

### Financial (all monetary amounts are shown in United States Dollar)

Total ISPA **Assets** as of December 31, 2025: **\$159,277**, which was down from **\$186,504** from 2024.

2025 **Income**: **\$68,915**, which was down from **\$112,074** in 2024

2025 **Expenses**: **\$49,361**, which was up from **\$26,928** in 2024

#### Notes:

- **Assets** for the society were down in 2025 as a function of **lower income** and **greater expenses**, compared to 2024.
- **Income** for the society was down in 2025 primarily as function of not being an ICPA year (which yields a return on investment).
- **Expenses** for the society were greater primarily because of website updates (\$16,000) and about \$5,000 in payments in travel reimbursement for ISPA site visits.
- ISPA annual membership dues for 2025:
  - Individual Membership: \$80
  - Student Membership: \$50
  - New in 2025, ISPA introduced the two-tier **Corporate Membership** level,
    - Basic Corporate Membership: \$700
    - Premier Corporate Membership: \$1,400
  - ISPA continues to offer the Developing Countries Membership Discount, a 50% discount for countries with low-income and middle-low-income economies as defined by the World Bank Organization.

#### Membership

- Members as of December 31, 2025: **337** (215 individual memberships, 118 student memberships, 4 Corporate memberships)
- Members as of December 31, 2024: **474** (297 individual memberships, 173 student memberships, 4 Corporate memberships)

#### Country Representatives

- Country Representatives as of December 31, 2025: **57** (covering 46 countries; 6 new countries that did not have representatives the year before)
- Country Representatives as of December 31, 2024: **49** (covering 40 countries; 4 new countries that did not have representatives the year before)

#### Additional Comments

The ISPA Board would like to thank all the members for input and suggestions for improving the ISPA operations and services.

In 2025, ISPA implemented a website redesign featuring expanded member resources and enhanced search capabilities to improve access to information (<https://www.ispag.org>).

The ISPA Board approved hosting the 17th International Conference on Precision Agriculture (ICPA) in Porto Alegre, Brazil, to be jointly held with the 11th Brazilian Congress on Precision and Digital Agriculture (11th ConBAP) in partnership with The Brazilian Association of Precision and Digital Agriculture. This marks the first time an ICPA conference will be held outside North America.
