



International Society of Precision Agriculture Pierre C. Robert Precision Agriculture Award Guidelines

The **Pierre C. Robert Precision Agriculture Award** honors individuals who have made significant contributions to precision sciences and technology. Two awards will be given in this category to a Young and a Senior Scientist/Professional. The young scientist/professional must be 42 or younger at the start of the conference; the senior scientist/professional must be over 42 at the start of the conference.

The nominee must be an active member of ISPA. The selected candidates will be honored during the conference award ceremony with a Plaque of Achievement and USD\$1,000 cash award.

Nomination: The nomination form should be completed online at: ispag.org/icpa/awards

Please collect all nomination materials before beginning the nomination form

NOMINEE Information: Include the name, title, affiliation, mailing address, telephone number, email address, headshot, and bio.

NOMINATOR Information: Include the name, title, affiliation, mailing address, telephone number, and email address.

Nominator's 1-page letter: (*nomination from the nominator*).

REFERENCES: Provide contact information (name, title, affiliation, mailing address, phone, and email) for two other individuals who are willing to submit (via separate email to awards@ispag.org) one-page reference/support letters.

Personal achievements: (*education, positions, and honors*)

- a. **Degrees received:** Give field, date, and institution for each degree.
- b. **Professional positions held:** Give name of each position, years, institution or organization, and locations.
- c. **Honors and awards received:** Honors and awards received.

Professional achievements/accomplishments:

- d. **Professional Contribution:** Identify and briefly explain the other contributions (other than publications) on which the nomination is based. Include significant achievements and accomplishments in teaching, outreach, research, industry, service, and leadership.
- e. **Membership:** List membership in professional, honorary, and academic societies; and service to recognized professional societies.
- f. **Publications/Patents:** List no more than 12 of the nominee's technical or non-technical publications or patents that demonstrate contribution to the science, technologies, or education programs or precision agriculture.
