The Value of Soil Testing for Long-Term Farm Decision-Making

Soil testing is often used for short-term decisions, but a longer-term vision is gaining ground. An MLA article makes the case for soil testing as a foundation for stocking rate decisions, and findings from the Soil CRC [Rural Landholder Survey](#) show that while farmers recognize its importance, implementation remains limited, often due to availability constraints.
